Pastor Humphrey is the chairman of our pastors and leaders in Kenya. The church has continued to pick steadily and with solid teaching of the word by the pastor.

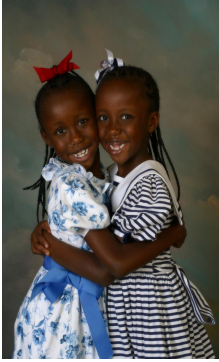

Let us all join in unison and meet the matching challenge.

One student will be seating for his exams and we hope and pray he can continue to university. Thanks for your gifts and love. Without your funds these children could not have attended the schools.
